

Try some new 1 foreplay moves: Start a game of "Show, don't touch." Demonstrate exactly how you like to be touched, and then have him do the same. "This is the best way for couples to show each other what drives them wild," says Emily Morse, a sex and relationship expert in Los Angeles and host of the Sex with Emily radio show and podcast.

No surprise here: A new study in the Journal of Sex Research found that the most satisfied pairs are affectionate and have sex ofteneven if one partner feels more like watching TV than getting frisky. The reason? There's a positive feeling associated with making your significant other happy, and by doing so, you win as well.

Guys dig it when your shyness disappears along with your pants, but switching to dominatrix mode can feel unnatural. Yvonne Fulbright, Ph.D., a sexual health and wellness ambassador for Astroglide, suggests asking his opinion. "It takes the question out of whether he'll dig the experience," she says. Tell him, for example, that you have a blindfold or vibrator stashed in the drawer, and see how he responds.

### His Biggest Insecurities

Men can be pretty

self-conscious: Many of our respondents admitted to having performance anxiety. So, how do get your guy to calm down? "In the moment, let him know what he does that feels good for you or turns you on," says Abraham Morgentaler, M.D., author of Why Men Fake It.

Forty-four percent of the men we surveyed also said their greatest fear during sex is finishing too soon. Avoid this by instructing your guy to slow down ("Most men believe sex requires constant thrusting," says Morgentaler, but doing so only speeds up climax), and tell him how hot it feels iust having him inside you. His confidence will rise. and he'll have more control over his ejaculation time.





Turn the 5 Turn the dialogue from PG-13 to R outside of the bedroom first, says Melissa Richman, Psy.D., L.C.S.W., a psychotherapist and relationship expert in Beverly Hills, California. During an intimate dinner, ask what he likes when you make love, then tell him the same. When you hit the sheets later, bring up those same points in a sexier tone—vou'll be surprised by how hot "So you like it when I...?" can sound.

He wants to He wants at talk about how many partners you've had in the past? Try not to have this conversation...ever. Other than your STD history (of course), "there is absolutely no reason your current partner needs to know everything about your past sexual exploits," says Morse. The same goes for you-knowing where he's been will only conjure up an ugly image. If he persists in asking, don't lie. Instead, ask him sincerely why he wants to know and how this info will be useful to him. If he can't explain himself, this may be a red flag that you should reevaluate this guy: He may be overly judgmental or insecure, says Morse.

A 2011 study published in The Journal of Sexual Medicine found that a widespread network of neurons are activated when men see sexually arousing images, and experts say it's erotic to a guy to watch himself in action. But should you costar? Morse doesn't recommend it. The exception: if you're in a long-term relationship and you destroy the evidence immediately after your viewing pleasure.
